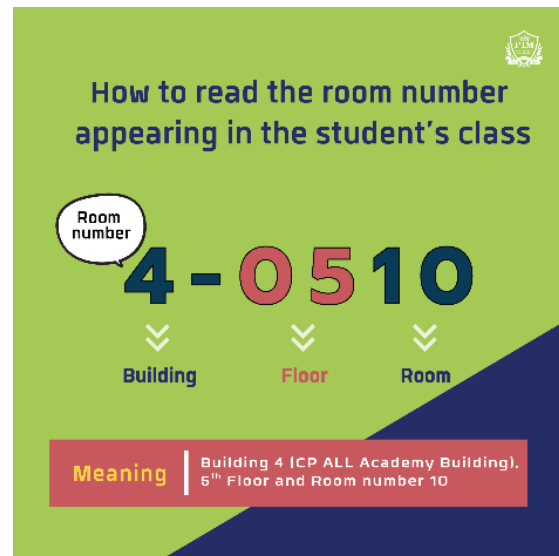
Around PIM: Chaeng Wattana

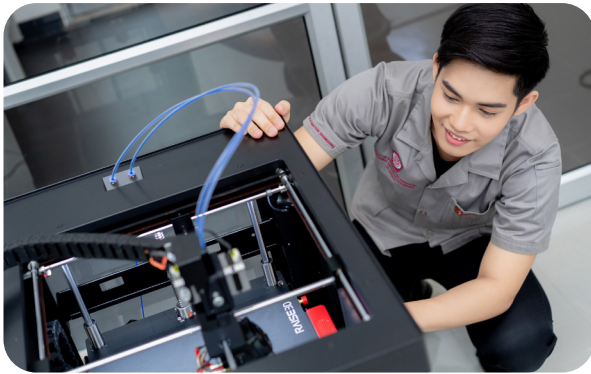

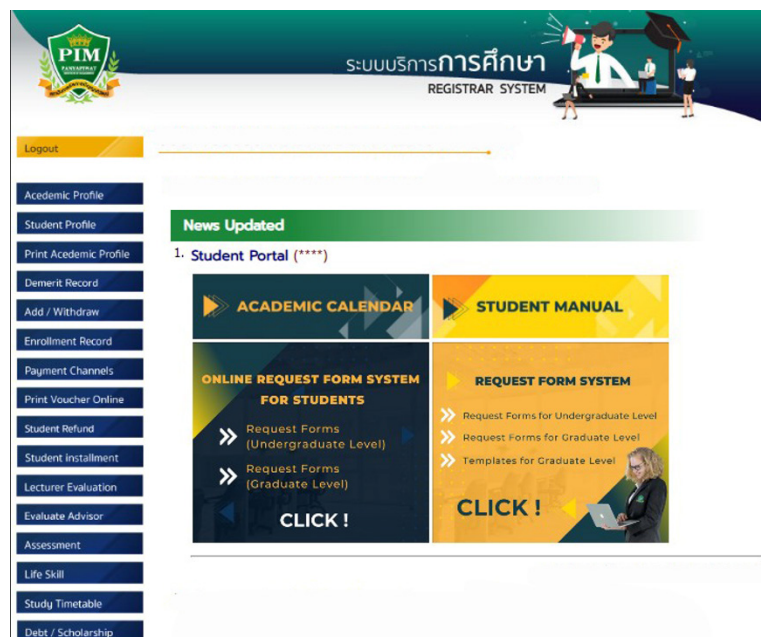


Registration System (www.reg.pim.ac.th)

The educational service system is used by the institution to aid students in their studies. It provides information on students' personal data, enrollment, increase-decrease courses, changing study groups, checking class and exam schedules, accumulated points, study reports, teacher and advisor evaluations, and graduation status.

To access the educational service system, students can go to PIM CONNECT (PIM LINE Official) and select the "REG (Educational Service System)" option. Once there, they can log in using their Single Sign-On Username and Password. Here is the link to access the system: <http://reg.pim.ac.th>.

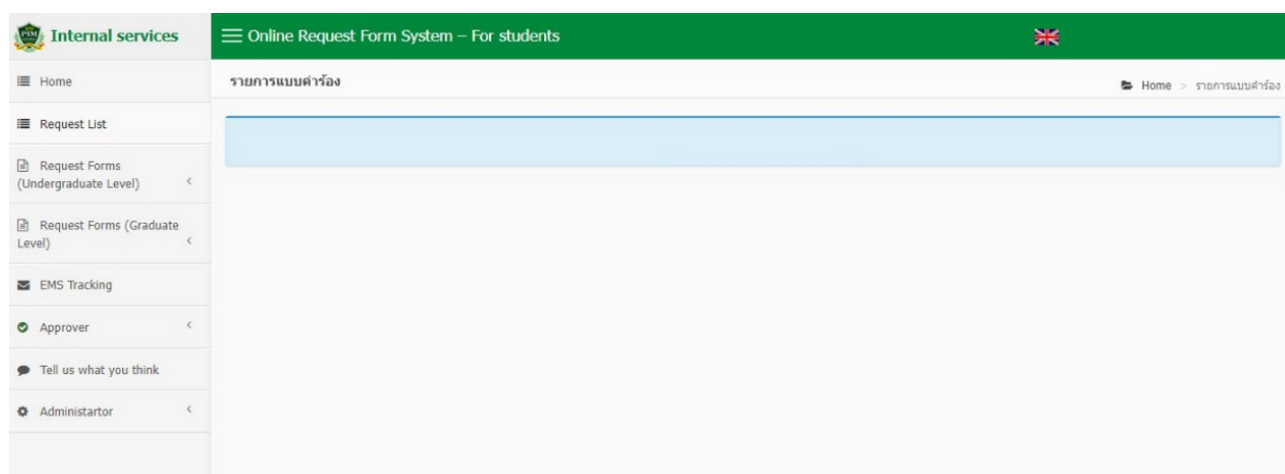
Internal Services

Students can submit an Online Request Form in the Internal Services system to request educational documents, adding-withdrawing courses, adding a course (in case of repeated registration), changing the study group, suspension of study/maintaining student status, etc. via PIM CONNECT (PIM LINE Official) (by choosing “Online Request Forms”)

Students can request the official academic documents, such as certification of student status or academic transcripts (available in both printed and digital formats), and other types of certifications. Additionally, students can submit online requests via the Internal Services system for actions such as course enrollment/addition (in cases of repeating courses graded F or W), Request Form for the Scores Inspection, leave of absence/Request for Retention of Student Status, Student Status Reinstatement Request, and graduation application. All requests are subject to the applicable fees as determined by the institute.

Students can access the Internal Service System (online request form) via PIM CONNECT (PIM LINE Official) by selecting the Online Request Menu to proceed with the requests of any operations required.

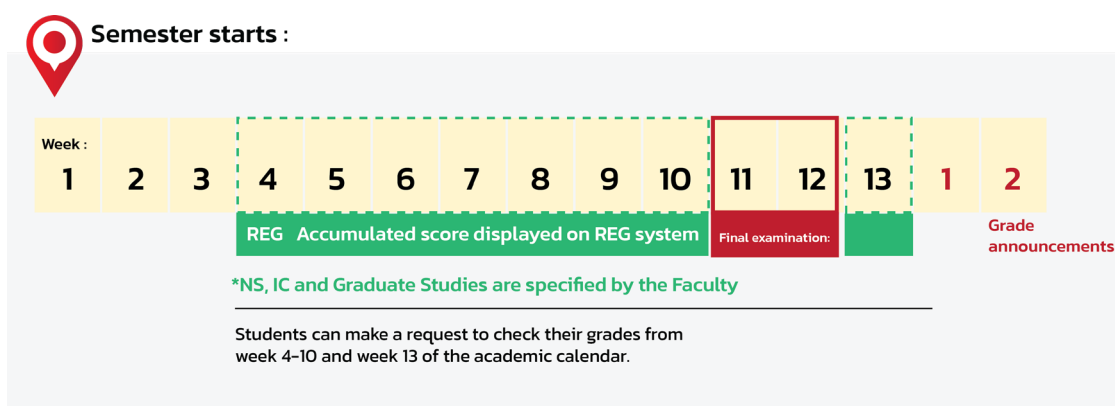
The Report Processing of Accumulated Scores during the Course

1. Dressed in business casual attire while taking the examination.
2. Please check the seat number every time before entering the examination room.
3. Students are not allowed to wear watches of all kinds during the examination
4. Students are not allowed to take the examination if they are more than 30 minutes late after the start of the examination. If they are more than 30 minutes late, they are considered to **"lose the right for taking examination"** in that particular course. Also, students are not allowed to leave the exam room for 45 minutes once the exam starts.
5. Students must always show "electronic student cards" or "people ID card" or "card issued by the government agency" or "substitution card for entrance to the examination room" to the examination room controller before entering the examination room.
6. Students are not allowed to make loud noises in front of the examination room.
7. Students must keep their own belongings, bags, or any valuables under the examination table

Prohibitions in Examination for Students

Any Student who does not observe or following Prohibitions is considered to be a cheater in the examination and must be punished as prescribed.

1. Turing on or using all types of communication tools or electronic devices while taking the examination.
2. Having the intention to commit other dishonest behaviors.
3. Taking the tests or the answer sheets out of the examination room.
4. Leaving the examination room during the examination excepting only in the case of permission from the examination room controller.
5. Taking the examination in place of the others or allowing the others to take the examination on one's own behalf.
6. Answering the test items for the others or allowing others answer the items for them.
7. Marking, writing, note taking, or acting in any way that results in any way that results in having messages or symbols on any part of the body or on any other object and bring it into the examination room.
8. Sending or receiving marks, signs or letters in any way during the Exam.

Penalties for Cheating in Examination

1. Grant F for the subject that is cheated
2. Deduct the behavior score (not exceeding 40 scores)
3. Put on probation
4. Deprive of the rights in scholarship

Requesting permission for retrospective

In the case of uncontrollable events preventing the students from taking the examination on the examination day and time, the students can request for a retrospective examination. They must file a request for retrospective examination with attached documents for consideration to the Academic Promotion Office within two days of the absent examination date.

The controllable events to be considered for retrospective examination request comprise the following:

1. Uncontrollable events that occur with the students, such as sickness or accidents that require hospital treatment. As such, the students must submit evidence or accompanying documents from the "hospital" only.
2. Uncontrollable events that are caused by external factors and have effects on the students including emergencies occurring with the parents, natural disasters, or epidemic diseases that prevent the students from taking the examination. As such, the students must submit evidence or accompanying documents for consideration.

Scholarships

At Panyapiwat Institute of Management, there is a policy to promote and support educational opportunities for students in accordance with the terms and conditions of their scholarship regulations.

The scholarship types for the academic year 2025 are as follows.

1. PIM scholarship: allocated to students of all faculties and disciplines
2. Training Scholarship for Working Preparation: educational funds given by CP ALL Public Company Limited
3. External Scholarships: educational funds from the generous, educational organizations and both external and domestic companies.
4. The Government Loan is the Student Loan Fund for Education (Ko.Yo.So)



Student Loan Fund is a government agency providing loans to destitute students to use the loans for their tuition fees, expenses related to education and expenses necessary for living during their studies. The scholar is

delivered to a student who meets the scholarship criteria/ qualifications (having family income according to the specified conditions and/or is a program/discipline that is the target group of the Student Loan Fund)

It is necessary that during the contracting process and the approval of the Student Loan Fund, the student must reserve the cost of tuition payments in advance. (This included the enrollment period in a special semester and the first semester of the academic year 2025)

According to a report by the Student Loan Fund, the Panyapiwat Institute of Management ranked first among private universities and 16th among all educational institutions in terms of repayment rates of the Student Loan Fund in 2025

Student Discipline

The Institute has determined regulations concerning student discipline in order to serve as guidelines for supervising students to be orderly. In the cases that students do not follow the rules and regulations of the Institute, such as inappropriately dressing, showing inappropriate behaviors and other wrong doings, they will be punished with disciplinary action. There are many dimensions of disciplinary punishment as follows:

If the student's scores have been reduced, what will happen?



Reduction of 40 - 60 points :
suspension of study for one semester



Reduction of 61 - 80 points :
suspension of study for two semesters



Reduction of 81- 99 points :
suspension of study for three semesters



Reduction of 100 points :
dismissal from the Institute.

6. Suspension of study
7. Dismissal from the Institute

Initial Medical Care



A team of doctors and nurses from Ramathibodi Hospital provides students with symptom assessment, first aid, and basic medication.

To receive this service, students must first obtain a 'referral form' from the Student Welfare Department, Student Affairs Office, located on the 8th floor, Room 4-0809, of the CP ALL Academy Building.

This form must then be submitted at the CP ALL HEALTH CARE CENTER, in the Villa B area, to receive initial medical treatment. The center is open for service from Monday to Friday, 08:30 AM to 5:30 PM.

(The service is not available on Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays, and substitution holidays.)

Gold health insurance scheme

The Office of Students' Activities can help students, who have Gold Health Insurance Scheme, that is available in their domicile in other provinces, transfer their scheme for the health service to the hospitals nearby PIM. Otherwise, the students can check their own scheme of health service via: NHSO Application, or the LINE application: @nhso. It is the regulation that a student can change the hospital under his/her scheme of health insurance providing by the government for 4 times/year.

Furthermore, students can transfer their health insurance schemes to Mithmitree Clinic, which has the MOU with PIM





Personal Accident Insurance

1. Insurance coverage for death, organ loss, and disability up to 200,000 baht.
2. Medical expenses up to 15,000 baht are covered by accident insurance. Students must reserve expenses before withdrawing insurance by;

If you happen to get into an accident, your insurance will cover the medical expenses up to a maximum of 15,000 baht per incident. However, if you're a student, you must first reserve your medical expenses before you can withdraw the insurance.

Here's how you can do it:

- 1) Access https://intranet.pim.ac.th/internalservices/student_request.php/th/request_form and select the online request form. Submit your compensation request.
- 2) Upload the following claim documents:
 - Claim form
 - Original receipt
 - Original medical certificate
 - Copy of ID card (signed and correct copy)
 - Copy of bank account page (signed and correct copy)
- 3) Wait for the status verification from the online request form.
- 4) Once the application status has been approved, there are two channels through which documents can be sent, as outlined below:
 - Documents can be delivered in person to the Student Affairs Office, which is located on the 8th Floor Room 4-0809 of Building 4 or at the CP ALL ACADEMY Building.
 - Alternatively, a letter can be sent by post to the Office of Student Affairs, which is responsible for student welfare. The address is: 85/1 Chaengwattana Road, Village No. 2, Bang Talat Subdistrict, Pak Kret District, Nonthaburi 11120.

Honors

Qualifications of students who are eligible to receive a degree with first class honor are as follows:

Degree with 1st Class Honor

1

1. Being a student in a bachelor's degree program including the second degree program.
2. Students earn the required number of credits in the curriculum and graduate within the time frame specified by the curriculum.

Please note that the period for which you are requesting a leave of absence must be included in the study period as specified by the curriculum. However, academic leave may be approved when requested by the student. With the approval of the Curriculum Administrative Committee, students may also be allowed to study abroad with an international student exchange scholarship or any other scholarship that directly benefits them.

3. Have never received disciplinary punishment in terms of educational suspension;
4. Have never received the grades of F, U, D, or D+ and have never had repeated registration in any course;
5. Students who have successfully transferred courses from another institution and have also transferred courses from the current institution may be eligible to receive an honours degree. However, it is important to note that the number of credits transferred must not exceed 25 % of the total number of credits required to complete the program.
6. To successfully complete the exam, it is mandatory to obtain a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 or higher

Degree with 2nd Class Honor

1. Being a student in a bachelor's degree program including the second degree program;
2. Students have completed the number of credits specified in the program, within the specified period. In this regard, it will be counted as the period of study including the time that the student requests for leave of absence; except for a leave of absence due to the student's approval of the program administration committee to study abroad with an international student exchange scholarship or any other scholarships that are directly beneficial to the students.
3. Have never received disciplinary punishment in terms of educational suspension;
4. Have never received the grades of F, or U and have never had repeated registration in any course;

If students enjoy studying and want to expand their knowledge and skills

The institution is here to help. We understand that some students may need more time to complete their studies, and we want to encourage everyone to succeed. Therefore, if you need extra time to complete your program, please note the following:

- **For a 2-year bachelor's degree program (4 semesters), the maximum duration of the graduation completion is 4 years (8 semesters).**
- **For a 4-year bachelor's degree program (8 semesters), the maximum duration of the graduation completion is 8 years (16 semesters).**

If a student has reached the maximum study period of their program without yet graduating, there are several options available to maintain their student status. These options are as follows:

1. Request to extend the study period by one semester at a time. This request must be made during the last semester and must be completed before the end of the semester.
2. Request a transfer of academic results to the curriculum at the Panyapiwat Institute of Management, where the teaching is organized.
3. Request to accumulate academic results in the credit bank of the Institute for Lifelong Learning. The Dean will consider and approve this request, taking into account the maximum benefits for the student.

The student can receive a scholarship under the criteria and requirements for eligibility and the obligations of the recipients.

How to request academic credit accumulation in "PIM Learning PLUS" (credit bank)

"PIM Learning PLUS (Credit Bank)" is a platform that registers academic results and credits for students. It covers formal education, non-formal education, and informal education, such as training courses. The aim of the platform is to provide learners and workers with an opportunity to connect their learning and work experience to accumulate credits in the Credit Bank. This is done by using reliable evidence as a component in calculating credits for accumulation.

Here are some examples of evidence that can be taken into account for transferring to accumulate credits.

They are:

1. Transcript of academic results in the course of study.
2. Results of tests by reliable agencies for certifying abilities, such as TOEIC and TOEFL scores.
3. Certificates from short-term courses obtained from various organizations, including educational institutions, government agencies, and the Professional Qualification Center.
4. Other necessary documents including certificates of work experience and proof of the individual's professional knowledge and expertise.

How to accumulate credits and use the results of credit accumulation"

Students can bring evidence of completed coursework and request credit transfer through the credit finance department at Panyapiwat Institute of Management in various channels provided.

1. Apply to collect credits



3. Accumulate credits



2. Provide evidence that can be submitted for transfer



4. Apply for the program you want to graduate from and study another 1/4 of the credits throughout the program in order to receive a degree.



For new PIM students, credits can be automatically accumulated into the institution's credit treasury system or "PIM Learning PLUS". The institution has asked every new student to consent to accumulate credits.

If a student exceeds the maximum study period of their program or if other learners are interested in accumulating credits through PIM Learning PLUS (credit bank) at Panyapiwat Institute of Management, they can accumulate credits to transfer them to the degree of their choice. Alternatively, they can request a student certificate from the credit bank and receive a report of their credit accumulation results. The decision to do so depends mainly on the needs of the students.

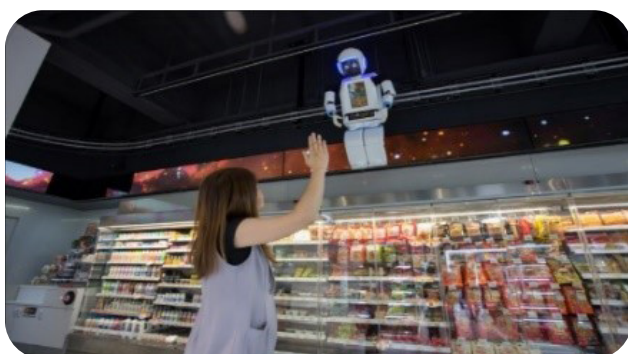
